In anticipation of the quiet man green way being approved I would like consideration to be given to a bicycle/Walking lane to be put in place from Belville railway bridge Monivea to Monivea village.

Grants should be provided for all businesses to build shower facilities for staff.

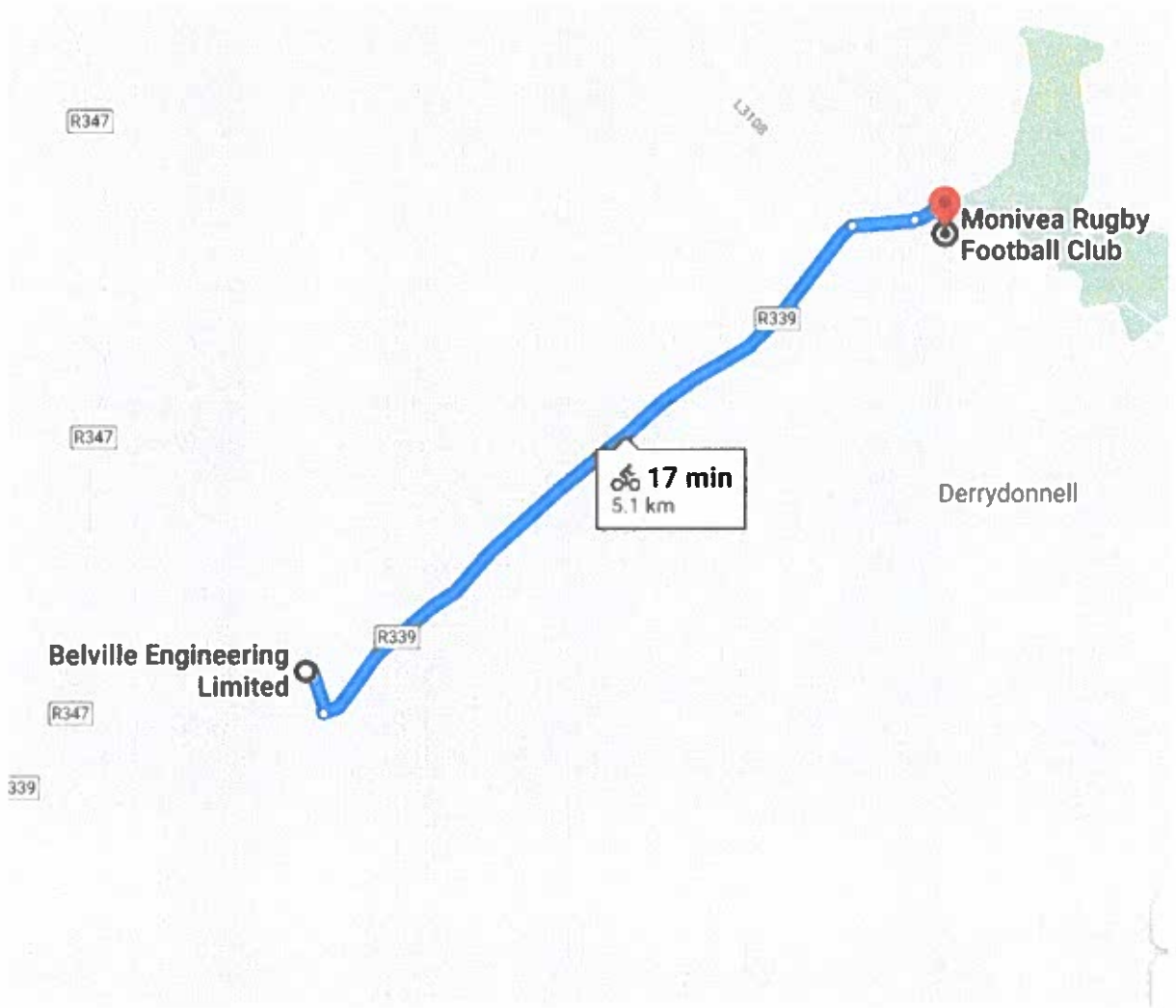
Galway is a perfect city to turn into a bicycle friendly city similar to cities in continental Europe.
