Scale 1:10,000 Extract from Admiralty Chart 1820

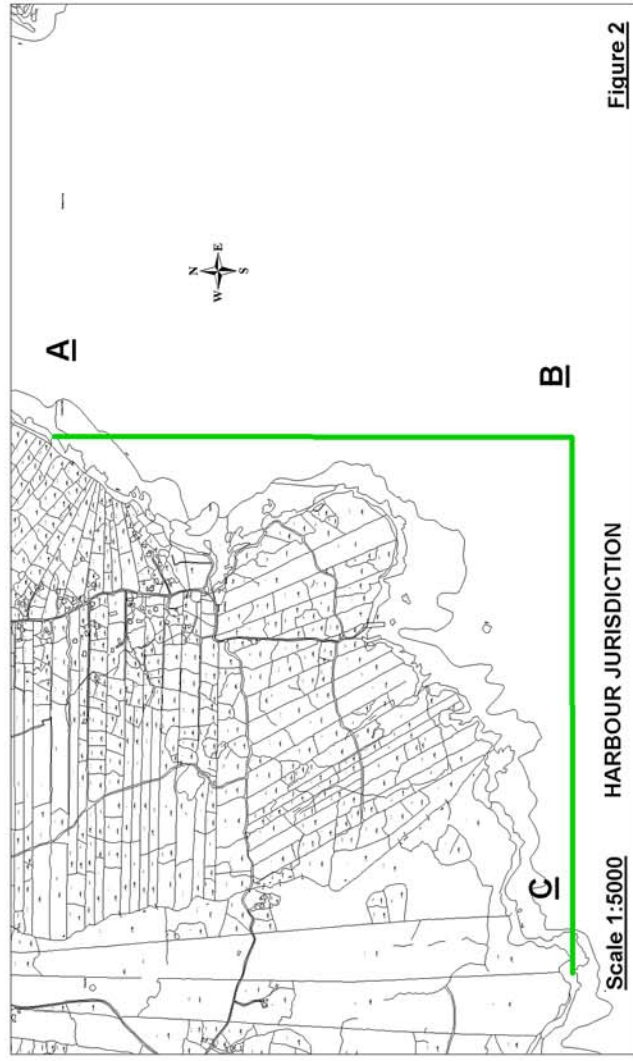

Scale 1:5000 HARBOUR JURISDICTION

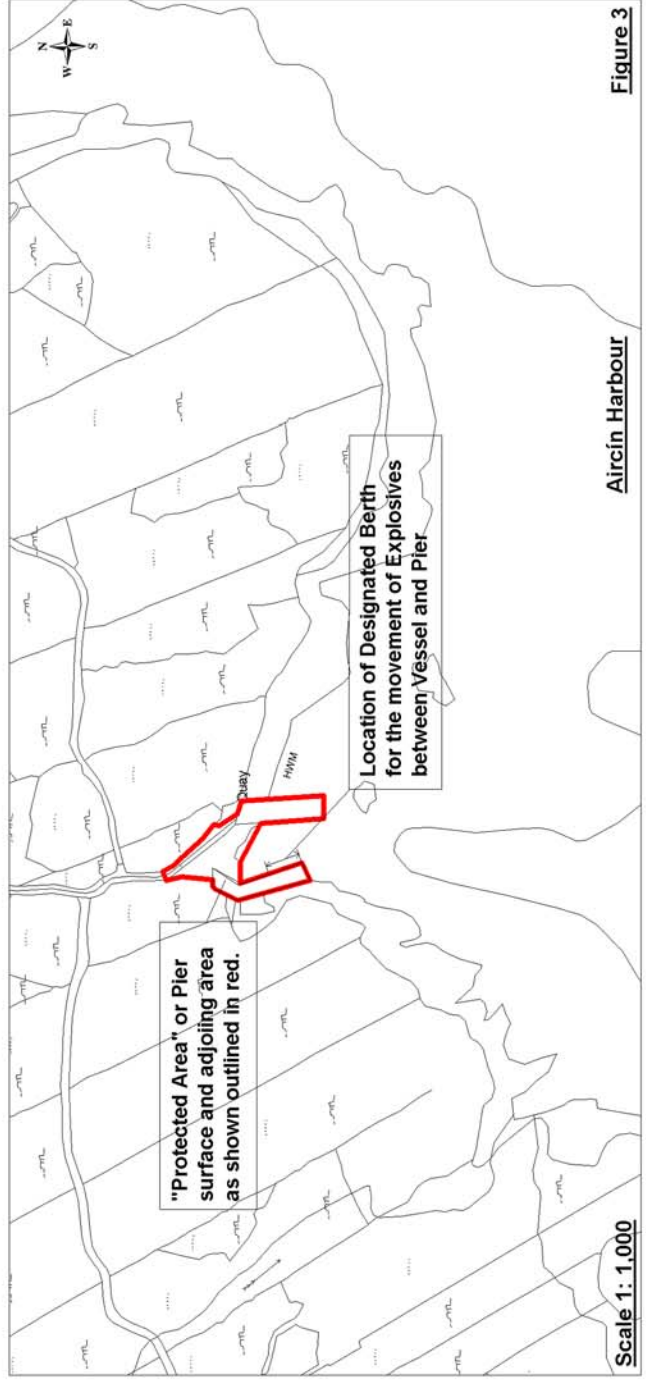
