



• County Galway has a slightly higher proportion of people over the age of 15 that have completed their education at Upper Secondary, Non Degree Level and Degree or higher level.


Figure 1Persons aged 15 years and over who's highest level of education


• The EDs to the North East, South East and far West, have the highest proportion of persons over the age of 15 that completed their education at primary school level.

Figure 2 Persons aged 15 years and over who's highest level of education completed is Second Level, ED's, County Galway, 2011




• The EDs to the North Galway and pockets in South Galway have the highest proportion of persons over the age of 15 that completed their education at Second level.

Galway






Figure 6 Persons aged 15 years and over by field of Study: Science, Business & Law, ED's County Galway, 2011




• The EDs close to the city and some in the west are most popular for studying Science, Business and Law.

• The EDs in South Connemara and pockets in the East of the County are most popular for studying Education & Teacher Training.




• The EDs to the East of the County are most popular for studying Agriculture & Veterinary
